### PSI STATE EXECUTIVE BOARD MINUTES SEPTEMBER 24, 1994

President Jean Barber called the Psi State Executive Board to order at 10:00 a.m. on September 24, 1994, at the Ramada Inn in Macon. Jean welcomed those present by groups, finding a high percentage were attending their first executive board meeting. A special welcome was given to the 1994-1996 chapter presidents, and to Psi State's newest chapter, Gamma XI, chartered in Brunswick, in May of this year.

An inspiration on hints for selecting a new wardrobe was given by Elouise Scott. Eva Egerton then led the group in singing the Delta Kappa Gamma song. Sylvia Daughtry, serving in the absence of the parliamentarian, declared the presence of a quorum for the transaction of business.

Introductions were made by Lounelle Beecher and were followed by the roll call by the recording secretary. One hundred eighty-three members were in attendance and all chapters were represented except Theta and Beta Kappa. A thank-you note from the family of Isabel Kinnett, past Psi State President, for money donated to the scholarship fund in her memory was read by Thelma Davis. Lounelle then read notes from those who had received assistance as a result of the floods, namely: Kate Hale, Xi; Lynda Cook, Xi; Rachelle Fowler, Xi; Rachel Thompson, Omicron; Lillian Parkman, Xi; Dorothy Riley, Xi; Grace Etheridge, Xi; and Kathleen Wheeler, Delta.

President Barber stated that the minutes of the last Executive Board meeting had been approved by the Executive Committee.

### REPORTS

**Treasurer:** Jackie Mann reported that three scholarships were granted during the past year, and seven contributions from the Emergency Fund were given to members who suffered flood loss. Seven gifts were made by the members of District I to the Boylston House Fund. Jackie urged the expense forms be sent directly to the president. She also stressed the importance of sending change of address cards to the International office to eliminate extra mailing costs. The treasurer's books have been audited and a copy given to those present.

**Executive Secretary:** Malissa Cox reported performing various responsibilities requested by the president and others. She stated that this year we will need to review and change Bylaws and Constitution and Standing Rules. Psi State Convention will convene on May 19-21, 1995, at Callaway Gardens.

The International Convention Theme was Delta Kappa Gamma Renewal - Dream, Dare, Do. Malissa challenged each of us to a renewal
