1899 Girls' High Graduate, Atlanta

1901 Further studies at New York University, Columbia University and Oglethorpe University

EXPERIENCE:

TEACHING AND PROFESSIONAL Atlanta Public Schools teacher: 5th grade classes at Fraser Street School (1903-1911); 1st grade classes at Fraser Street School (1911-1914); 2st grade classes at Atlanta Normal Training School (1914-1921); supervisor for primary grades (1921-1924); supervisor for kindergarten and primary grades (1924-1944)

DELTA KAPPA GAMMA LOCAL CHAPTER:

Alpha charter member (January 3, 1936); president (1943-1945); served in offices and on committees as assigned

PSI STATE ORGANIZATION:

1st vice president (1936-1938); 2nd vice president assisted in organization of Gamma and Delta chapters; first historian for Psi State (1950); served on committees as assigned; hosted visiting guests

REGIONAL (CONFERENCES, DUTIES, ACTIVITIES):

Sponsored regional conference in Atlanta (May, 1947); supported all programs; attended regional conferences; conducted workshops and programs; led discussions; introduced guests; gave reports; hosted Georgia reception for national guests

INTERNATIONAL(CONFERENCES, DUTIES, ACTIVITIES):

Met with national organization leaders to organize Psi State; first to attend a convention as Psi State representative in Washington, DC (1940); attended national conventions; gave reports; assisted with programs and workshops as assigned

Dedicated church worker; leader in many professional and community organizations; loyal member of United Daughters of the Confederacy, Atlanta Chapter

HONORS:

Psi State Founder; beloved by all who knew her; recipient of awards and recognitions in her profession and for her civic work
